The Laredo Independent School District was established in 1882. LISD is a district sprawling more than 13 square miles.

The Laredo Independent School District is made up of 33 educational institutions: 20 elementary schools, four middle schools, four high schools including the new Early College High School located on the campus of Texas A&M

International University, the Lara Academy our alternative education campus, an Non-Traditional high school, and three magnet schools. The three magnet schools are the Vidal M. Treviño School of Communications and Fine Arts, located in historical downtown Laredo, the Dr. Dennis D. Cantu Health Science School, located at Martin High School, and the Sabas Perez School for Engineering and Technology Education, located at Cigarroa High School.

The district has a yearly average of 25,000 enrolled students and over 4,500 employees striving for academic excellence. At the Laredo ISD, learning is the key to a bright and successful future. By setting high standards, the district plays a crucial role in preparing the students to meet the challenges and demands of today's high-tech and multicultural work place.

Laredo ISD Middle School & High School Art Program

All Middle School Art Programs have a Highly Qualified and State Certified Full Time Teacher; provide students with the opportunity to experience painting, print making, and drawing as part of the art curriculum; provide students with the opportunity to experience building three-dimensional art pieces; participate in school and locally sponsored art exhibits as well as the annual student art show at the Laredo Center for the Arts; and have many parents attend student events.

Laredo ISD Elementary, Middle & High School Cheerleading and/or Dance Team Program

All Elementary Cheer and / or Dance Programs have a Highly Qualified and State Certified Full Time Teacher / Sponsor; have students that participate in a Christmas Holiday Parade and the WBCA Parade; provide entertainment at school athletic events and / or other school and community events and are the official ambassadors for the school; participate in NCA competitions and events (Middle & High School only); and have many parents attend student events.

Laredo ISD Elementary School UIL Program

All Elementary UIL Programs have a Highly qualified and State Certified Full Time Teachers / Sponsor; provide at least 2 opportunities to attend local in local district meets; provide students with the opportunity to participate in the UIL District Meet; Hosted a UIL Invitational Meet or hosted the UIL District Meet; have many parents attend student events.

Laredo ISD Middle School UIL Program

All Middle School UIL Programs have a Highly qualified and State Certified Full Time Teachers / Sponso; provide at least 4 opportunities to attend local in district meets; provide at least 1 opportunity to attend an out of town district meet; provide students with the opportunity to participate in the UIL District Meet; and have many parents attend student events.

Laredo ISD High School UIL Program

All High School UIL Programs have a Highly qualified and State Certified Full Time Teachers / Sponsor; provide at least 4 opportunities to attend local in district meets; provide at least 3 opportunities to attend an out of town district meet; provide students with the opportunity to participate in UIL District, Bi-district, Area, Regional and State Meets if they qualify. Hosted a UIL Invitational or hosted the UIL District Meet; and have many parents attend student events.
